Re: Canada needs a more ambitious emissions reduction target

To the Honourable Jonathan Wilkinson,

This is a critical decade for climate action.

I commit to take action **For the Love of Creation.**

Starting now, I will _____.

The world is not on track to hold global temperatures to 1.5°C over pre-Industrial levels, as committed to in the Paris Agreement. And failing to do so will bring irreparable damage to the planet. Canada, which historically has caused significant GHG emissions and continues to have among the highest per capita emissions, is not doing enough. This must change.

I appreciate Canada's commitment to achieving net-zero GHG emissions by the year 2050 and the measures announced in late 2020 to orient Canada towards that goal. At the same time, it is imperative that Canada take responsibility for our ongoing contributions to climate change, commit to a more ambitious emissions reduction target, and take action now to transform our society and our economy.

Minister, will you commit to reducing Canadian GHG emissions by 60 percent below 2005 levels by 2030? And will you commit to doing so while investing in a just transition to a fair, inclusive, green economy that creates good secure jobs, and promotes the well-being of everyone in Canada?

The world requires nothing less.

I also urge you to collaborate with your colleagues in the work of honouring Indigenous rights and supporting climate adaptation and mitigation in the Global South.
